# BRIAN PERKS. MAY 24, 1934 – TUESDAY MAY 14TH, 2024

#### SUSAN HENDRICKS SHARES SOME MEMORIES:

I first met Brian in 1993 at a meeting organized by those of us who had attended a support group in Toronto. We wanted to gauge the level of interest in Durham Region for an affiliate of Bereaved Families of Ontario. Everyone there, except for the BFO Toronto professional advisor, was fairly new to the experience of child loss but we knew from our experience in Toronto that sharing the myriad of feelings unique to child loss with other bereaved parents was one of the most healing things we had been able to do and we wanted to share that with others. (Brian would tell me that is a run-on sentence, but never mind!).

I will never forget Brian: he sat in the back row and listened to what was said but in the question period that followed, he stood up in his wonderfully imposing way and briefly told the story of his daughter Brenda's death on Christmas Eve several years before. Then, irascible chap that he was, came: "How will talking about it or listening to other people's stories take away my pain of loss? She's gone!" he thundered. No one else had questioned the usefulness of the project and we struggled for words to convince him that it might help. I honestly thought we would never see him again. But by attending that meeting, his name was now on our mailing list! Gotcha, Brian! We didn't hear from him for some time. He never joined a support group – BFO's programme focus – but his call came when we started to publish a very amateur newsletter. Brian had founded a very successful publishing company in the early 1960's, Perks Publications. Brian knew his strengths and how to make best use of them in Brenda's memory. Ever the professional, he wanted to volunteer by offering Perks Publications and his services as its Editor.

He was relentless with his pen, removing unnecessary words, re-arranging and shortening paragraphs to maintain the reader's interest. I learned so much from him that influences my professional writing to this day.

Having established Perks Publications as our official printer, there was never a thought to ask anyone else to print the Angels' Tree of Lights programmes and posters. From our first tree in 1995, his daughter Cindi assisted us in creating the program and Perks Publications provided enough copies for each person attending to take one home as a souvenir. That original programme format is still in use today. BFO Durham recognized them in 1996 with our Volunteer of the Year Award. They deserve so much more than that official nod.

Brian and his daughter Cindi's generosity still bring hope to so many: many of us keep those programmes in our 'memento boxes', looking at them from time to time and in so doing, realize that though our families experienced traumatic losses, together we have been slowly creating a new family of hope and healing.

Brian also purchased years' worth of mother and child statues for the award created to honour my work with BFO. Without words, that simple act spoke to the depth of our caring and appreciation of each other.

Who can say what makes people friends? We shared a similar loss; our daughters having died on significant Christian holidays. We didn't see each other outside of BFO activities but a heart connection was established between us right from the start. We never shared emotions or feelings or what the friendship meant to us: it just was. We worked together to help others.

I remember a few lines from a poem that I read when a teenager: :

You, like Eros over Piccadilly,

Were always there.

I cannot find the words to leave you with.

God speed, dear friend.

#### **MONKEY BUSINESS - ONGOING FUNDRAISER**





Dear Friends of BFO-Durham - This is the Story behind the Monkey Business Workshop This endeavor is in memory of my son, Shane Reymes, who sadly passed away in April of 2022 at the young age of 46.

My son Shane was given a sock monkey for his first birthday by his Aunt. That monkey went everywhere with him throughout his life. Here is a picture of Shane as a small boy with his Aunt and his brand-new monkey.

As the years went by and after it being dragged around everywhere, it started to wear and fray so I had to re-cover it. With the assurance from me that his real monkey was underneath the new repair sock, he enjoyed years and years of continued friendship with his monkey. Even as an adult his monkey could always be found somewhere, such as on a dresser or shelf or sometimes even on his bed.

So, this past Christmas I decided that I would start making monkeys in memory and in honour of Shane's beautiful life with ALL monies raised going to charity in his name. The specific charity for this part of the project will go to BFO-Durham.

I found BFO-D after my son passed away and participated in the Mother's group. The people at BFO-D are such wonderful people and the cause is so needed at a time when the suffering of profound grief is so unbearable. This is a small way that I can give back to those who helped me so much in those early days and who continue to do so today.

I have made a collection of 52 monkey styles that are available for sale. Each one is "one of a kind" however if what you choose has already been purchased, I will re-make any one of them to resemble, as closely as possible, to your choice including the fabrics and accessories. Special requests are available within reason. You can request the PDF catalogue by emailing or calling me directly.

So, may I encourage you to think about participating in this project by buying one or more monkeys? They are recommended for age 4+ and that includes adults! These monkeys would be perfect to give as gifts or to sit on your bookshelf, in your office or in another special place.

#### Here is a little information about each monkey:

- the monkeys and outfits are hand made in Canada by me (Marlene, Shane's Mom) and made with much love.

-each monkey is approximately 18" - 22" in height depending on the design.

-each monkey has inserted into it, one rose quartz crystal to represent the monkey's heart. The rose quartz crystal is typically known as a healing crystal and is the stone of universal love. These rose quartz crystals come from a big collection of gemstones and crystals that belonged to Shane.

-to make ordering easier, each monkey has been named by immediate family and all have a special meaning to us. However, please feel free to re-name your monkey to whatever you would like once you receive it. -all appendages are double, or triple sewn for secure attachment.

-the eyes are triple sewn and glued for secure attachment.

-each monkey is hand washable - lay flat to dry, as indicated on the sewn-on label.

-all proceeds from the sale of the monkeys will go to BFO-D. I am contributing the cost of all the material and my time to the cause.

Thank you for your generous support of this project. If you request a catalogue, please feel free to pass it on to anyone whom you think would like a very special monkey for a very special cause!

# New support group for long term grief

It was suggested by several members that BFO Durham offer a closed support group for long term grief.

Our grief for the loss of our child does not have a time limit however many things can change as the years go by. Do we still get the support from family and friends? Do people still remember? Are there problems at work? How have we changed as the years passed? What new traditions or memorials have we created to honour of our child? These are just some of the possible topics that could be discussed and shared in a long-term grief support group.

BFO Durham will be offering a 6-week closed group to provide support and address the issues surrounding long term grief.

The first group will begin this coming September. It will be a mixed group of moms and dads who are **5yrs or more** beyond their loss **and have previously attended an initial support group**.

If this first group is successful, and there is a demand from members, then this support will continue to be offered as needed. We will also learn from this group, and make any changes needed to improve it if necessary




